Please accept this correspondence as an extension of my July 26, 2018, letter of representation to you in your capacity as the court-appointed liquidator of ReliaMax Surety Company.

As you will recall, I undertook representation of you to issue several opinions last summer relating to the possible sale of the corporate shell, insurance licenses and selected assets of ReliaMax Surety Company to Gallatin Point, along with the potential placement of tangible and intangible assets and liabilities of the company in a separate legal entity. I would note that I had issued an opinion letter to you dated August 6, 2018, in that regard

Gallatin Point did not proceed with a purchase and acquisition of the assets of ReliaMax Surety Company but now there is another potential purchaser, Comenius MGA, LLC, which is owned in whole by Peter Shaw and Todd Stevens. As you know, Comenius has asked that I represent them in a Form A filing to acquire certain assets of ReliaMax. I have sent Comenius a retainer agreement along with a request for a waiver of any potential conflicts regarding my representation of Comenius in the Form A filing and my representation of you as Liquidator regarding receiving court approvals as are necessary regarding this transaction as outlined in my August 6, 2018, opinion. I would note that we have already received your written waiver of any conflicts with Comenius and once we receive the waiver of conflicts from Comenius we will be sure to share the same with you.

I would propose to charge you the same hourly rate as I am charging Comenius, \$300 per hour, for services in petitioning and securing court approvals. In addition to this we are required to charge 6.5 percent professional sales tax and would ask that you reimburse us for any costs

incurred in our representation. We will send billings on a monthly basis. Make sure to let me know if this is not acceptable.

I would expect that my services to you under this agreement would include identifying assets to be purchased by Comenius as well as identifying the assets that need to be transferred to a separate legal entity to remain in the liquidation estate, identification and possible creation of a legal entity to whom we could transfer the remaining assets and liabilities of ReliaMax Surety Company following the Form A acquisition, petitioning the court for approval of the upcoming transfer and sale of assets of ReliaMax Surety Company to Comenius, and securing court approval for the transfer of the remaining assets and obligations of ReliaMax Surety to a separate legal entity after the sale to Comenius. There would also be representation of the Division in communications with Comenius and coordinating the acquisition and control of the company through a Form A filing with the petitions for various approvals of the Circuit Court.

The billings to you will only relate to the separation of assets of ReliaMax and matters relating to the application and receipt of court approval for this and approval of the sale under the Liquidation proceedings. All billing for the Form A filing, hearing and approval will be the responsibility of Comenius. No double billing will occur between the two. Of course if you ask for other related services those will also be your responsibility.

If you are in agreement with the terms of our representation, I would ask that you execute this correspondence in the space provided below and return the same to me. For that purpose I have provided an addressed and postage prepaid envelope. Make sure to let me know if you have any questions.
